**SUBJECT: AVAILABILITY OF FEMA FACE COVERINGS**

Airport Council International – North America (ACI-NA) has coordinated with the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to provide cloth face coverings to airport workers and passengers throughout the United States. FEMA has allocated an initial supply of 166,000 coverings for distribution at John F. Kennedy International Airport. We expect to receive additional quantities over the coming weeks.

The face coverings are for all airport employees, to include (but not limited to) those working for air carriers, terminal operators and FBOs, ground support service providers, concessionaires, cargo handlers, rental car companies, janitorial service providers and others. They may also be given to passengers. These coverings are washable and reusable.

If ordering for employees, quantities should be limited to two per employee until replacements are needed.

As a reminder, face coverings are required for all individuals in public areas of passenger terminals and other public facilities and conveyances. This requirement is inclusive of the secure area outside air terminals, such as ramp and apron areas, cargo loading areas, the Airport Credentialing Office, and other areas where the density of operational or business activity prevents proper social distancing. Exemptions to this requirement are outlined in General Manager's Bulletin #2020-22.

Cloth face coverings are an economical and environmentally friendly alternative to disposable masks. I encourage the airport community to take advantage of this federally funded supply of coverings.
